AN ACT CLARIFYING THE EFFECT OF FINDINGS ON MOTOR VEHICLE SURCHARGE APPEALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 113P of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the

6 preclusive effect on any claim in tort for property damage or  
7 personal injury, arising from the same incident which gave rise  
8 to the proceedings under this section.
