AN ACT INCREASING THE FEES COLLECTED BY CITY/TOWN CLERKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 262 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out the fees of certain subsections and inserting in place thereof
3 the following: —

5 (13A) four dollars, (14) ten dollars, (20) twenty dollars, (21) ten

8 dollars, (44) five dollars, (44A) four dollars, (45) ten dollars,
9 (54) ten dollars, (57) twenty dollars, (58) twenty dollars, (62) forty
10 dollars, ten dollars for each add'l. street/way, (66) five dollars,
11 (67) five dollars, (69) ten dollars — first page, two dollars each
12 add'l page, (75) twenty dollars, (78) ten dollars, (79) ten dollars
13 — first page, two dollars each additional page.

14 and add the following subsection: —

15 (80) For certifying any public document in the custody of the
16 Town/City Clerk, five dollars.
