### AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXEMPTIONS FROM PERSONAL INCOME TAXES FOR CERTAIN MILITARY PERSONNEL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 5A of chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 (d) In applying this section, the compensation paid to citizens
- 4 of the commonwealth by the United States, who are uniformed
- 5 military personnel assigned to duty at military posts, bases or
- 6 stations outside the United States, shall be deemed to be from
- 7 sources other than sources within the commonwealth.
