*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 20 of Chapter 21 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
- 3 following paragraph: —
- 4 (14) To disseminate information regarding amendments to the
- 5 general and special laws of the commonwealth, proposed changes
- 6 in laws and rules and regulations which affect or shall affect
- 7 businesses in the commonwealth; and, to establish educational
- 8 outreach programs for the purpose of assisting small business to
- 9 implement required changes in legislation.
