AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF STEAM BOILERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 46 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end thereof the following sentence: — Nothing in this section shall
4 be construed to require continuous attendance at a steam boiler
5 or engine, or to prohibit periodic absences or the performance of
6 certain other tasks by an operator.
