AN ACT CLARIFYING THE PROCESS BY WHICH CERTAIN LAWS OR REGULATIONS ARE DECLARED NOT TO BE EFFECTIVE IN CITIES OR TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The first paragraph of section 6B of chapter 11 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by adding the following sentence: — Any action to declare a
- 4 general or special law or administration rule or regulation not to
- 5 be effective in any city or town shall be governed by the provisions
- 6 of subsection (E) of section twenty-seven C of chapter twenty-
- 7 nine.
