AN ACT PROHIBITING HOLIDAY BENEFITS FOR BUNKER HILL DAY AND EVACUATION DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 state employees and employees of state authorities shall not
- 3 receive holiday benefits for Bunker Hill Day and Evacuation Day.
- 4 Provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not
- 5 interfere with existing collective bargaining agreements.
