AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF ONE MASTER PLUMBER BY ANOTHER MASTER PLUMBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 3A of chapter 142 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section 5 of
3 chapter 843 of the Acts of 1977, is hereby further amended by
4 adding the following sentence: — The provisions of this section
5 shall not prohibit the employment of one master plumber by
6 another master plumber even if the master plumber so employed
7 does not have a journeyman's license.
