### AN ACT REQUIRING THE TEACHING OF PRACTICAL ARTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 17A the following section: —
- 3 Section 17B. Every town of twenty thousand inhabitants shall
- 4 maintain the teaching of a course in practical arts for all students
- 5 without regard to sex, including in such course both manual
- 6 training and household arts as part of both its elementary and
- 7 its high school program of studies.
