AN ACT TO RESTRICT SMOKING IN CERTAIN PUBLIC PLACES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22 of Chapter 270 of the General Laws, as created by
2 Chapter 759 of the Acts of 1987, is hereby amended by striking
3 the first sentence therein and inserting in place thereof the
4 following: —

5 No person shall smoke in any public elevator, drug store or
6 pharmacy, supermarket or retail food outlet, in or upon any public
7 mass transit conveyances or indoor platform or enclosed outdoor
8 platform, at any open meeting of a governmental body as defined
9 in section eleven A of chapter thirty A, section twenty-three A
10 of chapter thirty-nine and section nine F of chapter thirty-four,
11 in any laundry or dry cleaning establishment as regulated pursuant
12 to sections eighteen A and eighteen B of chapter ninety-three, in
13 the seating area, corridors or restrooms of any indoor stadium,
14 auditorium or theatre or in any courtroom.

The Committee on the Judiciary of the Senate and the Committee on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives have the honor to report to the Senate and the House of Representatives, respectively, the following bill for legislation to amend existing law relating to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress assembled, on this day of July, 1957.

- 1 Section 21 of Chapter 177 of the District Code, as amended by
- 2 Chapter 200 of the laws of 1957, is hereby amended by striking
- 3 the first sentence therein and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 4 following:
- 5 "The Federal Bureau of Investigation is an agency of the Federal
- 6 Government, established by the Executive Order of August 1, 1949,
- 7 and shall be organized and operated in accordance with the
- 8 provisions of any act or acts of Congress and any rules and
- 9 regulations of the Federal Bureau of Investigation established
- 10 by the Board of Directors of the Federal Bureau of Investigation,
- 11 in any manner which may be deemed appropriate by the Board,
- 12 in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the Executive Order,
- 13 the Senate and the House of Representatives, and any act or
- 14 regulation of the Board or in any court."
