**AN ACT TO INCREASE THE AVAILABILITY OF REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR HEAD INJURED PERSONS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 as appearing in the 1990 edition of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by adding after Section 82 the  
3 following new section: —

4 Section 82B. There is hereby established on the books of the  
5 Commonwealth a separate fund to be known as the Trust Fund  
6 for Head Injury Treatment Services. Said trust fund shall consist  
7 of moneys paid to the Commonwealth pursuant to the provisions  
8 of section 24 of Chapter 90 for the purposes of developing and  
9 maintaining nonresidential rehabilitation services for head injured  
10 persons. The commissioner shall serve as the trustee of the trust  
11 fund which shall be administered for the benefit of persons with  
12 head injuries.

13 The state treasurer shall be the custodian of the Trust Fund,  
14 and shall receive, deposit and invest all moneys transmitted to him  
15 by a court of the Commonwealth for the Trust Fund, and shall  
16 credit interest and earnings on such funds to said Trust Fund.  
17 Upon request of the commissioner in his capacity as trustee, the  
18 state treasurer shall pay out of the income and receipts of the Trust  
19 Fund in such a manner as the trustee may direct. Expenditures  
20 from the Trust Fund shall not be used for any purpose for which  
21 the commission has been appropriated funds in the prior fiscal  
22 year, nor shall funds appropriated or allocated to the commission  
23 be reduced on account of the Trust Fund.

1 SECTION 2. Section 24 of chapter 90 as appearing in the 1990  
2 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting after the  
3 paragraph ending with the word "program" in line 75 the  
4 following new paragraph: —

5 There shall be a fee of one hundred dollars assessed against a  
6 person convicted of, pleading guilty to, assigned to an alcohol  
7 education or rehabilitation program, or placed on probation for  
8 operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating  
9 liquor, marihuana, narcotic drugs, depressants or stimulant  
10 substances, pursuant to the provisions of this section; provided  
11 however, that moneys collected pursuant to said surcharge shall  
12 be deposited by the court with the treasurer into the Fund for  
13 Head Injury Treatment Services.
