AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPULSORY LIABILITY OF DRIVERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Be it enacted that licensed drivers involved in traffic accidents
- 2 shall not, without a determination of fault by an impartial fact
- 3 finder, be found at fault solely because the driver was making a
- 4 left hand turn across traffic. Neither shall a surcharge be levied
- 5 on the individual's auto insurance without such a determination.

The Constitution of the State of New York

Article 13, Section 1

Every person who operates a motor vehicle shall be liable for the damages caused by such operation.

As a condition of the license and privilege of operating a motor vehicle, every person shall be required to obtain and maintain such liability insurance as shall be prescribed by law.
