*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Subsection (e) of section 25 of chapter 151A, as amended by
- 2 section 19 of chapter 26 of the acts and resolves of 1992, is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out clause (2) and inserting in place thereof
- 4 the following clause: —
- 5 Section 19 (e) (2). (2) by discharge shown to the satisfaction
- 6 of the commissioner by substantial and credible evidence to be
- 7 attributable to deliberate misconduct in wilful disregard of the
- 8 employing unit's interest, or.
