AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGULATION OF DOGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The third paragraph of section 139A of
2 chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1988 Official
3 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following clause: — (5)
4 training for animal control or dog officers.

1 SECTION 2. Section 151A of said chapter 140, as so
2 appearing, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 16 and 17
3 the word “ten” and inserting in each case in place thereof the
4 word: — seven.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 151A of said chapter 140, as so
2 appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out in line 18
3 the words “male or any spayed female”.

1 SECTION 4. Said section 151A of said chapter 140, as so
2 appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out in line 67
3 the following “male or any spayed female”.
