### AN ACT RELATIVE TO COLLEGE CREDIT FOR COURSES IN AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 15A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 9 the following section: —
- 3 Section 9A. Public institutions of higher education which offer
- 4 courses in American sign language shall award course credits
- 5 which must be used toward fulfilling foreign language
- 6 requirements for degrees.
