AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 17 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws as appearing
- 2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in
- 3 line 6 after the word "license;" the following phrase: — provided
- 4 that any person duly authorized, other than a city or town clerk,
- 5 by the direction to issue licenses at their place of business located
- 6 within the commonwealth may charge and retain a convenience
- 7 service charge, in addition to said license fee, from an applicant
- 8 not to exceed one dollar and fifty cents, per issued license;
