AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE FORMS TO INCLUDE AN ORGAN DONOR QUESTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following section: —

4 Section 47K. Every health insurance policy shall include a
5 separate questionnaire asking the insured whether they are willing
6 to donate any organs for either medical science or a transplant
7 operation.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 176A of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following section: —

4 Section 8K. Every health insurance policy shall include a
5 separate questionnaire asking the insured whether they are willing
6 to donate any organs for either medical science or a transplant
7 operation.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter 176B of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following section: —

4 Section 4M. Every health insurance policy shall include a
5 separate questionnaire asking the insured whether they are willing
6 to donate any organs for either medical science or a transplant
7 operation.

1 SECTION 4. Chapter 176G of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following section: —

4 Section 4E. Every health insurance policy shall include a
5 separate questionnaire asking the insured whether they are willing
6 to donate any organs for either medical science or a transplant
7 operation.
