## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

### AN ACT CLARIFYING THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING MEETINGS AND RECORDS IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section six of chapter one hundred and fifty E of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended  
3 by adding the following sentence: — Any meetings held pursuant  
4 to this section or pursuant to section eight shall not be subject  
5 to the provisions of sections twenty-three A through twenty-  
6 three C of chapter thirty-nine or sections eleven and eleven A of  
7 chapter thirty A and any documentary materials or data,  
8 regardless of physical form or characteristics, prepared for or in  
9 connection with such meetings by any officer, employee or agent  
10 of the employer shall not be deemed a public record, provided,  
11 however, that a collective bargaining agreement which has been  
12 executed by the employer and the exclusive representative shall  
13 be a public record.
