### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF JULIAN BELL.

1     *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of promoting the public good,  
2 and after an appropriation has been made therefor, there be paid  
3 out of the state treasury to Julian Bell of Peru, who while an  
4 employee of the department of revenue was suspended on March  
5 twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight, for an alleged  
6 violation of the conflict of interest laws and after a hearing by  
7 an arbitrator was ordered reinstated on September twenty-fifth,  
8 nineteen hundred and ninety, the sum of eight-two thousand,  
9 seven hundred twenty-two dollars and ninety cents, representing  
10 payments for one hundred thirty weeks of lost wages.
