AN ACT REGULATING UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection b of section 28A of chapter 151A of the Massachu-
2 setts General Laws is hereby amended by inserting at the end
3 thereof the following new language: —
4 “and provided, further, that if the employee continues his
5 employment for the second of such academic years or terms the
6 employee shall refund any and all unemployment benefits received
7 during such period between two successive academic years or
8 terms, over and above any compensation received for services
9 performed as stated in the contractual agreement, to the
10 department of employment and training;”
