## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE SECURITY SYSTEMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 47 of chapter 147 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
- 3 the first paragraph the following: —
- 4 “Within six months after the passage of this act, all motor
- 5 vehicles which are registered in the commonwealth which are
- 6 equipped with security systems containing an audible alarm shall
- 7 also be equipped with a device which shall be adjusted so that
- 8 any audible emissions designed to signal to persons outside the
- 9 vehicle shall cease after two minutes of operation.”
