The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the
2 retirement allowance of any person formerly employed as a
3 teacher in the public schools of the Commonwealth shall not be
4 less than seventy-five hundred dollars per annum retroactive to
5 January one, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight, provided that
6 each such person shall have completed not less than twenty years
7 of creditable service.

8 In any case where the spouse or other surviving beneficiary of
9 a person formerly employed as a teacher in the public schools of
10 the Commonwealth who had completed not less than twenty years
11 of creditable service, the retirement allowance of such beneficiary
12 shall be not less than nine thousand dollars retroactive to January
13 one, nineteen hundred ninety-three.

14 This act shall become effective upon its passage.
