RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF USING SURPLUS FEDERAL PROPERTY AS JAILS AND CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of  
3 representatives, the commissioner of the department of correction  
4 or his designee and three persons to be appointed by the governor,  
5 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
6 and study relative to the feasibility of using surplus federal  
7 property in the commonwealth as jails and correctional  
8 institutions.
