AN ACT FURTHER REGULATION DRUNKEN DRIVING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 24E of the following section: —

3 Section 24E½. In addition to all other penalties prescribed by
4 law, a person who is convicted of operating a motor vehicle while
5 under the influence of intoxicating liquor shall be prohibited from
6 purchasing or receiving alcoholic beverages as defined in section
7 one of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight.

1 SECTION 2. Section 34B of chapter 138 of the General Laws,
2 as amended by chapter 674 of the acts of 1989, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — Any person who shall have
5 attained age twenty-one and who is not prohibited from
6 purchasing or receiving alcoholic beverages under the provisions
7 of section twenty-four E½ of chapter ninety may apply for a liquor
8 purchase identification card.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 34B of said chapter 138, as
2 appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby further amended
3 by striking out in lines 11, 12 and 13 the words “or motor vehicle
4 license issued pursuant to sectin eight of chapter ninety”.

1 SECTION 4. Said chapter 138 is hereby further amended by
2 inserting after section thirty-four D the following section: —

3 Section 34E. No person licensed under this chapter shall sell
4 or deliver an alcoholic beverage to any person until such person
5 shall prove he is entitled to purchase or receive such alcoholic
6 beverage by producing a valid liquor purchase identification card
7 in his name.
