AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISTINCTIVE LICENSE PLATES FOR RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The sixth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the third sentence the following
4 sentence: — The registrar may upon payment of the registration
5 fee as required in section thirty-three, issue to a retired member
6 of the armed services of the United States, upon presentation of
7 satisfactory evidence of such membership, as determined by the
8 registrar, distinctive registration plates for one pleasure passenger
9 vehicle owned and principally used by said member.
