The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENTS FOR CERTAIN FORMER EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of Section 102 of M.G.L.
2 Chapter 32 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the second
3 sentence after the words "general court shall determine" the
4 following: — "and in the case of former employees of the
5 Massachusetts Port Authority, if a higher percentum than that
6 determined by the general court is authorized by majority vote
7 of the Board of the Massachusetts Port Authority, the retirement
8 allowance, pension or annuity of every former employee of the
9 Massachusetts Port Authority shall be increased by such
10 percentum as the Board shall determine. In the event the general
11 court fails to provide for such an increase, the retirement
12 allowance, pension or annuity of every former employee of the
13 Massachusetts Port Authority or of the Spouse or other
14 beneficiary of any such former employee of the Massachusetts
15 Port Authority shall be increased by such percentum as the Board
16 of the Massachusetts Port Authority, by majority vote, shall
17 determine.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (c) of Section 102 of M.G.L.
2 Chapter 32 is hereby amended by inserting after the words
3 "general court" in the first sentence, the following: — "or the
4 Massachusetts Port Authority, as the case may be, as provided
5 for in paragraph (a) of this section,".
