Thompson (with the approval of the city council) for legislation to require the Personnel Administrator to certify the names of members of the city of Cambridge police reserve force prior to certifying any other list or register. AN ACT REQUIRING THE PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO CERTIFY THE NAMES OF MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE POLICE RESERVE FORCE PRIOR TO CERTIFYING ANY OTHER LIST OR REGISTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special act to
2 the contrary, and particularly chapter 31, section 40 of the General
3 Laws, the Personnel Administrator of the Commonwealth, upon
4 the request of the appointing authority of the city of Cambridge,
5 shall certify for permanent appointments as police officers, the
6 names of members of the city of Cambridge police reserve force
7 who were appointed to that force April 29, 1991, prior to certifying
8 names from any other list or register, including names from any
9 reemployment list established pursuant to chapter 31, section 40
10 of the General Laws.
