By Mr. Draisen of Boston, petition of Marc D. Draisen for legislation to reduce the cost of motor vehicle repairs. Insurance.

AN ACT TO REDUCE AUTOMOBILE REPAIR COSTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 340 of chapter 90 is hereby amended by
2 inserting after the thirteenth paragraph the following new
3 paragraph: —

4 The provisions of any other law or regulation to the contrary
5 notwithstanding, no law or regulation shall be construed so as to
6 preclude any insurer from providing any insured with a separate
7 list comprised of only those registered repair shops which have
8 agreed with the insurer to comply with the requirements of the
9 thirteenth paragraph of this section.

1 SECTION 2. Section 1130 of chapter 175 is hereby amended
2 by inserting after the fourth paragraph the following new
3 paragraph: —

4 The provisions of any other law or regulation the contrary
5 notwithstanding, no law or regulation shall be construed so as to
6 preclude any insurer from providing any insured with a separate
7 list comprised of only those registered repair shops which have
8 agreed with the insurer to comply with the requirements of the
9 fourth paragraph of this section.
