AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF STURBRIDGE TO ESTABLISH A CERTAIN FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-three of chapter
2 forty-four of the General Laws or any other general or special law
3 to the contrary, the town of Sturbridge may establish in the town
4 treasury a special revenue fund which shall be kept separate and
5 apart from all other monies by the treasurer of said town and in
6 which shall be deposited any net surplus realized from the
7 operation of the town sewer system. The principal and interest
8 thereon may be expended, subject to appropriation, for new
9 construction and extraordinary maintenance as the town engineer
10 with the approval of the town may determine.
