In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN THE TOWNS OF CHARLTON AND SOUTHBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The following described line shall hereinafter
2 constitute a portion of the boundary line between the towns of
3 Charlton and Southbridge.
- 4 Beginning at a granite monument standing at the corner of the
5 towns of Charlton, Southbridge, and Sturbridge and being the
6 same bound N 07° 40' 54" W, and nine hundred forty-two and
7 fifty-five hundredths (942.55) feet distant from corner 1 (SS-1) of
8 Sturbridge and Southbridge;
- 9 Thence N 08° 21' 59.5" W, for a distance of one thousand eight
10 hundred twelve and fifty-eight hundredths (1812.58) feet to a
11 corner 1 (CSS-1) of the towns of Charlton, Southbridge and
12 Sturbridge, also located S 08° 21' 59.5" E, a distance of eight
13 thousand five hundred seventy-three and eighty-four hundredths
14 (8573.84) feet from the Charlton and Sturbridge corner 2 (CS-2);
- 15 Thence N 70° 45' 42.4" E, for a distance of six hundred ninety-
16 two and eight hundredths (692.08) feet to a corner A (CS-a);
- 17 Thence S 06° 42' 02.3" E, for a distance of one thousand one
18 hundred ninety-one and nineteen hundredths (1191.19) feet to
19 corner B (CS-b);
- 20 Thence N 79° 09' 45.7" E, for a distance of seven hundred
21 ninety-eight and forty-five hundredths (798.45) feet to corner C
22 (CS-c);

23 Thence S $03^{\circ} 25' 59.9''$ W, for a distance of four hundred
24 eighty-five and seventy hundredths (485.70) feet to the existing
25 Charlton and Southbridge corner I (CS-1), also located
26 N $68^{\circ} 34' 56.9''$ E, a distance of one thousand three hundred
27 seventy-nine and three hundredths (1379.03) feet from the point
28 of beginning, and so describing Area 1.

29 Thence N $68^{\circ} 14' 36.2''$ E, for a distance of one thousand five
30 hundred ninety-three and forty-eight hundredths (1593.48) feet to
31 corner 1A (CS-1a);

32 Thence N $08^{\circ} 05' 28.2''$ W, for a distance of one thousand six
33 hundred ninety-one and fifty-five hundredths (1691.55) feet to
34 corner 1B (CS-1b);

35 Thence N $70^{\circ} 32' 37.3''$ E, for a distance of seven hundred
36 eighty and eighty-nine hundredths (780.89) feet to corner 1C (CS-
37 1c);

38 Thence S $07^{\circ} 35' 48.7''$ E, for a distance of two thousand eight
39 hundred thirty-six and thirty-four hundredths (2836.34) feet to
40 corner 1D (CS-1d);

41 Thence N $71^{\circ} 59' 06.4''$ E, for a distance of six hundred four
42 and thirty-three hundredths (604.33) feet to corner 1E (CS-1e);

43 Thence S $25^{\circ} 07' 45.0''$ W, for a distance of one thousand one
44 hundred sixty-four and sixty-one hundredths (1164.61) feet to
45 corner 1F (CS-1f), a point on the present boundary line, also
46 located S $64^{\circ} 38' 14.8''$ E, a distance of two thousand six hundred
47 ninety-two and eighty-four hundredths (2692.84) feet from
48 corner 1 (CS-1), and so describing Area 2. Said last point 1F also
49 being N $64^{\circ} 38' 14.8''$ W, and seven thousand two hundred sixty-
50 eight and eighty hundredths (7268.80) feet distant from corner 2
51 (CS-2).

1 SECTION 2. The following described land shall hereinafter
2 constitute a portion of the boundary line between the towns of
3 Charlton and Southbridge:

4 Beginning at the corner of Charlton and Southbridge known
5 as corner 5 (CS-5) marked by a vertical granite stone, which is
6 N $81^{\circ} 56' 39''$ E, six hundred three and sixty-four hundredths
7 (603.64) feet distant from corner 4 (CS-4), said corner 4 being at
8 the junction of stone walls;

9 Thence southwesterly to a point and thence along a curve to
10 the left along the easterly side of the proposed Prince Road to
11 corner 5A (CS-5a) marked by a granite monument;

12 Thence N $73^{\circ} 19' 22.0''$ E, for a distance of four hundred
13 twenty-eight and sixty-five hundredths (428.65) feet to corner 5B
14 (CS-5b), a point on the present boundary line, which is located
15 S $11^{\circ} 22' 20.0''$ E, and six hundred eighty and fifty-five
16 hundredths (680.55) feet distant from the point of beginning, said
17 last point also being N $11^{\circ} 22' 20.0''$ W, and nine hundred forty-
18 seven and fifty-six hundredths (947.56) feet distant from corner 6
19 (CS-6).
