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**AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING GROUP INSURANCES FOR CITIES  
AND TOWNS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 10A of Chapter 32B of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the  
3 following paragraph: —

4 Any county, city, town or district which does not provide dental  
5 benefits under this chapter may provide that any general, group  
6 or blanket insurance policy it purchases makes dental benefits  
7 available to employees at said employees' own expense.
