AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE SALE OF KEGS OF BEER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph: —

4 Any licensee who holds a license under the provisions of this
5 section shall require a refundable deposit of fifty dollars be paid
6 in connection with the sale of each keg of beer, ale and malt
7 beverage. The provisions of this paragraph shall be enforced by
8 the local licensing authority. Any unredeemed deposits shall be
9 turned over to the city or town on a quarterly basis to be used
10 in alcohol or public safety education programs.
