**AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRANSIENT VENDORS IN THE TOWN
OF BARNSTABLE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections one through
- 2 twelve A, inclusive, of Chapter one hundred and one, the town
- 3 of Barnstable shall exempt any individual licensed under said
- 4 chapter from the local fee, charge, deposit or bond required;
- 5 provided, however, such exemption shall apply to the sale of
- 6 merchandise held in temporary indoor events of not more than
- 7 five days duration in the town of Barnstable.
