By Mr. Petersen of Marblehead, petition of Douglas W. Petersen (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Swampscott to lease a certain parcel of land to the Joseph L. Stevens Post 1240, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Inc. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SWAMPSCOTT TO LEASE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section three
2 of chapter forty of the General Laws, but subject to the provi-
3 sions of chapter thirty B of the General Laws, the town of Swamp-
4 scott, acting by and through its board of selectmen and chief
5 procurement officer, is hereby authorized to lease or rent, a certain
6 parcel of land and buildings thereon, acquired for public works
7 purposes, to the Joseph L. Stevens Post 1240, Veterans of Foreign
8 Wars, Inc., for a term not to exceed twenty years upon such terms
9 and conditions as the board of selectmen and chief procurement
10 officer shall determine.

11 Said parcel is shown as a portion of Lot 3 on Assessors
12 Plate 3.

1 SECTION 2. In consideration for the lease described in
2 section one, the Joseph L. Stevens Post 1240, Veterans of Foreign
3 Wars, Inc., shall convey in fee to the town of Swampscott
4 Lots 581, 582, 588, 590, 591 and 592 shown on Assessors
5 Plate 9.
