AN ACT RELATIVE TO COLD STORAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 94 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out lines 5 through 7, inclusive.

1 SECTION 2. Section 1 of Chapter 94 is hereby further
2 amended by striking out lines 16 through 18, inclusive, and
3 inserting in place thereof the following:— “Cold storage,” the
4 storage of food at or below a temperature of forty-one degrees
5 Fahrenheit for a period of thirty days or more.”

1 SECTION 3. Section 1 of Chapter 94 is hereby amended by
2 striking out lines 19 through 23, inclusive, and inserting in place
3 thereof the following:— “Cold storage or refrigerating ware-
4 house,” an establishment employing refrigerating machinery
5 where food is stored for thirty days or more at or below a temper-
6 ature of forty-one degrees Fahrenheit.”

1 SECTION 4. Sections sixty-six, sixty-six A, sixty-seven, sixty-
2 eight, sixty-nine, seventy, seventy-one, seventy-two, seventy-
3 three, and seventy-three A of Chapter ninety-four, as appearing in
4 the nineteen hundred and ninety-six Official Edition, are hereby
5 repealed.

1 SECTION 5. Section 305C of Chapter 94 is hereby amended by
2 inserting, in line 6, after the word “warehouse,” the words “or
3 cold storage or refrigerating warehouse.”; and by striking, out in
4 line 9, the words “sixty-six,” and in line 38, by inserting after the
5 word “commissioner,” the words:— “of the Department of Public
6 Health.”
