AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION TO THE STATE POLICE VIOLENT FUGITIVE ARREST SQUAD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 62E of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the word "system", in line 8, the following
4 words:— or the State Police Violent Fugitive Arrest Squad, for
5 the purpose of performing their duties including identifying and
6 locating outstanding wanted felon fugitives.

1 SECTION 2. Section 17A of chapter 66 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the word "control", in line 30, the following
4 words:— and provided, further, that the State Police Violent
5 Fugitive Arrest Squad shall be provided with information from the
6 department's records or files for the purposes of performing their
7 duties including identifying and locating outstanding wanted felon
8 fugitives.

1 SECTION 3. Section 46 of chapter 151A of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the last subsection (5), in line 30, the following
4 new subsection:—
5 (6) to the State Police Violent Fugitive Arrest Squad, informa-
6 tion necessary in the performance of their duties including identi-
7 fying and locating outstanding wanted felon fugitives.
