AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO PERSONS SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8E of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in
3 line 1, the word “eighteen” and inserting in place thereof the
4 word: — sixteen; and by adding at the end thereof the following
5 sentence: — Any person sixty-five years of age or older may be
6 issued an identification card under this section and no payment of
7 a fee shall be required.
