AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETURN OF ADDITIONAL SALES TAX REVENUE TO
CITIES AND TOWNS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
- 3 following paragraph:—
- 4 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
- 5 the contrary, twenty percent of the excise received under this
- 6 section shall, at least semi-annually, be credited, distributed and
- 7 paid by the state treasurer, upon certification of the commissioner,
- 8 to each city and town in which the sale at retail occurred.
