AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LABOR RELATIONS COMMISSION FILING AND INVESTIGATIVE PROCEDURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 150E, Section eleven, line 4 of the
2 Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 1996 Official
3 Edition, is amended by adding the following new sentence:— The
4 complaint or charge made to the Commission shall be sufficient to
5 require an in person investigation by the Commission provided
6 only that it contains a brief summary of the factual basis of the
7 charge.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 150E, Section eleven is further amended
2 by rewriting the current second sentence to read:— The
3 Commission may dismiss a complaint without a hearing if it finds
4 no probable cause to believe that a violation of this chapter has
5 occurred.
