### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PENALTIES FOR UNAUTHORIZED PARKING IN A HANDICAPPED SPACE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 22A of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in
- 3 lines 61 and 62, the words “twenty-five dollars or in excess of one
- 4 hundred dollars” and inserting in place thereof the words: — fifty-
- 5 dollars or in excess of two hundred and fifty dollars.
