RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO ENACT LAWS PROVIDING FOR GOVERNMENTAL IMMUNITY.

1 *Resolved*, That the general court of the commonwealth of
2 Massachusetts respectfully requests the Congress of the United
3 States to enact a law providing cities, towns, counties and states
4 and their employees immunity from civil liability; provided, how-
5 ever, if gross negligence and willful acts are involved a city, town,
6 county or state may be held liable up to the amount of one hun-
7 dred and fifty thousand dollars and employees up to ten thousand
8 dollars. School teachers and police officers shall be immune for
9 any civil liability but may be subject to discharge.
