AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN PERSONS AS MOTORCYCLE PASSENGERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 13 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 word "car" in line 39 the following words:— provided, however,
- 4 no person shall ride as a passenger who is under the age of
- 5 sixteen years.
