AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ASSESSMENT OF LOCAL TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5, Clause 41 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended in
3 line 763 by striking the word "six" and inserting in place thereof
4 the word "thirteen"; and further amend in line 765 by striking the
5 word "seven" and inserting in place thereof the word "fifteen";
6 and further amend in line 780 by striking the word "seventeen"
7 and inserting in place thereof the word "twenty-eight"; and further
8 amend in line 789 by striking the word "twenty" and inserting in
9 place thereof the word "thirty"; and further amend in line 800 by
10 striking the word "six" and inserting in place thereof the word
11 "thirteen"; and further amend in line 802 by striking the word
12 "seven" and inserting in place thereof the word "fifteen"; and fur-
13 ther amend in line 804 by striking the word "twelve" and inserting
14 in place thereof the word "twenty-eight"; and further amend in
15 line 806 by striking the word "fifteen" and inserting in place
16 thereof the word "thirty".
