AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF AYER FOR USE BY THE AYER DISTRICT COURT DIVISION OF THE DISTRICT COURT DEPARTMENT OF THE TRIAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioner of the division of capital planning and oper-
2 ations in the name of and on behalf of the commonwealth, is
3 hereby authorized, pursuant to the provisions of sections forty E
4 through forty J of chapter seven of the General Laws, to acquire
5 certain real property located in the town of Ayer for use as a
6 parking lot at the Ayer District Court Division of the District
7 Court Department of the trial court, at 18 Prospect Street and is
8 more particularly described as follows:

9 Beginning at the southwesterly corner of the granted premises
10 at the intersection of Prospect Street and School Street;

11 thence, running northerly by said School Street forty-six and
12 zero hundredths (46.00) feet;

13 thence, turning at a right angle and running easterly by land of
14 Nellie E. Fox, sixty-four and zero hundredths (64.00) feet;

15 thence, turning at a right angle and running southerly by land
16 of Nellie E. Fox forty-six and zero hundredths (46.00) feet to said
17 Prospect Street;

18 thence, turning at a right angle and running westerly by said
19 Prospect Street sixty-four and zero hundredths (64.00) feet to the

20 point of beginning, this line making a right angle with the first
21 described line.

22 Said parcel contains two thousand nine hundred forty-four and
23 zero hundredths (2,944.00) square feet more or less.

24 Being the same premises conveyed by Marie P. Walsh to
25 Marie P. Walsh, Trustee of the Mid-Hill Trust dated April 4, 1974
26 and recorded at the Middlesex south district registry of deeds in
27 Book 12610, Page 553.
