AN ACT RELATIVE TO FIREARMS IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 Registrar of Motor Vehicles shall establish an electronic database
3 for individuals who are in possession of a firearms identification
4 card. Said firearms identification card information shall be bar-
5 coded on an individual's driver's license in addition to the infor-
6 mation already contained therein.
