AN ACT RELATIVE TO STREETLIGHT MAINTENANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of section 34A of chapter 164 of the
2 General Laws, as recently amended by section 196 of chapter 164
3 of the Acts of 1997, is hereby further amended by striking out, in
4 clause (iii), the words “or compensate” and inserting in place
5 thereof the following words:— with the consent of.

1 SECTION 2. Said paragraph (a) of said section 34A of said
2 chapter 164, as recently amended by section 196 of chapter 164 of
3 the Acts of 1997, is hereby further amended by striking out, in
4 clause (iii), the word “for”.

1 SECTION 3. Paragraph (b) of said section 34A of said
2 chapter 164, as recently amended by section 196 of chapter 164 of
3 the Acts of 1997, is hereby further amended by inserting after the
4 word “subsection (a)” the following:— , and shall be required to
5 use the distribution company operating in the city or town to
6 maintain any streetlights located on poles that also support elec-
7 tric distribution facilities.
