AN ACT AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND REHABILITATION OF CERTAIN COMMUTER RAIL STOPS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority is hereby
- 2 authorized and directed to rehabilitate and construct rail stops
- 3 located on the Red Line in the City of Boston, including stops
- 4 within the 2nd Suffolk District.
