AN ACT TO PROVIDE UNLIMITED MBTA PASSES FOR PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS THAT MEET CERTAIN SCHOOL ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whereas over 50% of current Boston public school students
2 miss 30 out of 180 days of school, and whereas current attendance
3 of public high school students is abysmal, the MBTA is hereby
4 directed to provide unlimited MBTA passes for public high school
5 students that meet certain school attendance requirements which
6 may include perfect attendance and the like.
