AN ACT TO FURTHER EXEMPT PROPERTY TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 59, Section 5, Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following new subsection:—
- 3 Seventeen E. Real estate shall be exempt for a home owner
- 4 who has reached sixty-five years of age, and who has owned and
- 5 occupied said home for twenty-five years while paying property
- 6 tax on said home for twenty-five years, and whose annual income
- 7 does not exceed \$40,000.
