The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, any municipal employee who was denied entry into
3 the retirement system and who later is permitted entry into said
4 system shall be entitled to buy creditable service for the time he
5 was employed without being in the retirement system. He may
6 buy such creditable service at any time up to three years after
7 retirement.

8 The retirement boards of the cities and towns of the common-
9 wealth, in conjunction with the city council, town council or
10 board of selectmen, shall hold meetings with employees or
11 retirees who were denied entry into the retirement system to solve
12 such problems. Said meetings shall be public hearings or execu-
13 tive sessions at the option of the employee.
